**Purpose:** The **Partnerships for Innovation** (PFI) is a collaboration of Nebraska secondary and postsecondary partners focused on building a better statewide system of Career and Technical Education (CTE) to improve



student learning and better meet economic development priorities. PFI will do this by introducing innovation in delivery systems in CTE to include Career Academies, professional development and programs of study with coordinated curriculum between secondary and postsecondary education providers.

# **Programs of Study and Coordinated Curriculum**

- 1. Facilitate the Standards Writing for Human Services, Hospitality & Tourism, Information Technology, STEM: Engineering, and Arts, AV & Communications. All courses are available on the <a href="PFI website">PFI website</a> and by October 15, 2012 will be aligned with Nebraska Academic Standards and National Common Core Standards.
- 2. Assist with the development and facilitation of <u>reVISION</u>; a Program of Study development process in partnership with Educational Service Units and schools which integrate Labor Market Information and Nebraska's Economic Industry Clusters.
- 3. Create educational videos made available on the PFI website and shown at NCE Fall Workshops which communicate:
  - a. How to use Labor Market Information found on <u>H3.ne.gov</u> to develop local programs of study tied to regional workforce and economic development needs
  - b. The research behind dual credit, how to integrate more dual credit in local CTE programs of study, and making connections with local community colleges.
- 4. Partner with NDE to evaluate the Program of Study process impact in secondary and postsecondary schools.
- 5. Work with the Nebraska community colleges to create an online course credit warehouse of available CTE articulated within state model Programs of Study.
