Voluntary Participation

Participation in the Career Academy Program is voluntary. If a student does not like the Career Academy, they can opt out entirely at semester or change academy programs at the end of the school year. Students will be required to provide a written essay as to why they are opting out or changing Academy Programs.

Recognition

Career Academy students who have completed the Academy Program will be recognized with at the ABC Ceremony in the spring. Most Career Academy students will graduate high school with XX college credits from XYZ College which start them on the path toward a degree.
