Awardees will be contacted on or before August 9, 2013 via email.

Please note: Scholarships are limited to **ONE** conference per person. PFI or its staff is not responsible for coordinating participant travel, conference registration, meals or lodging. School districts or community colleges will be responsible for providing all up-front costs for participants. Consider accessing Perkins funds if they are available for the additional costs. PFI scholarship payments will be made directly to a school district or community college after the workshop with confirmation of participant attendance.
